

# Thunder Press Color Settings for Photoshop CS2

Before you can select the color settings in Photoshop the appropriate ICC profile and CSF file must be placed into the appropriate folders. Photoshop will need to be restarted in order to see the new profiles.

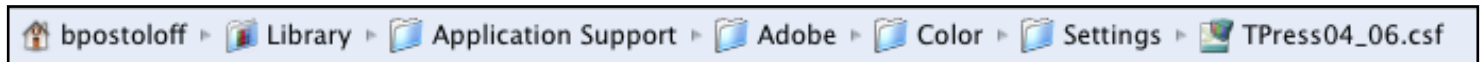
1. The profile: “**Newspaper IFRA97\_1 U240 K90.icc**” was supplied by one of our print houses. Place the file into the Settings folder in the following path (see Image 1) **Computer: Library: Application Support: Adobe: Color: Profiles**

2. The CSF file: “**TPress04\_06.csf**” was exported from our PhotoshopCS2 and is our recommended color settings for Photoshop. Place the file into the Settings folder in the following path (see Image 2) **User: Library: Application Support: Adobe: Color: Settings**

3. **Open Photoshop** and go to Edit in the menu bar and pull down to “Color Settings” (com+sh+k). (See image 3)
4. Under settings, **pull-down to TPress04\_06**
5. **Make sure** that “Newspaper IFRA97\_1 U240 K90” appears next to CMYK
6. **Your Color Settings should match this screen capture**
7. Remember these are the color settings that we recommend for Thunder Press, not any other magazines or newspapers
